Launch of the Preferred Pharmacy Network

Starting January 1, 2017, the Manitoba Public School Employees Benefit Plans will include a preferred pharmacy network for prescription drugs. This new feature of your Health plan is being introduced to help you save money on prescription drugs, to offer the convenience of free home delivery for maintenance drugs and to make it easier for you to manage your condition and be healthier. All of this for no extra cost to you – and it is up to you, if you would like to use the network.

How does it work?

The preferred pharmacy network consists of two pharmacies – Costco Pharmacy for short-term prescriptions and Express Scripts Canada (ESC) Pharmacy[®] for long-term prescriptions (i.e., maintenance drugs).

How do you save if you use these two pharmacies?

1. You will only pay **10%** of the prescription drug cost (the Health plan will cover 90% of the cost instead of 80% – that is a 10% higher reimbursement from when you use other pharmacies).
2. You pay lower dispensing fees (from as low as **\$4.50** at Costco to **\$9** with ESC – other pharmacies charge **\$9.25 to \$14**). Your plan's dispensing fee cap is \$7, so if you fill your prescriptions at Costco you will not be out-of-pocket, and if you use ESC Pharmacy[®], you will only be \$2 out-of-pocket.
3. ESC fills up to a **90-day** supply of prescription drugs, so if you take a maintenance drug you will only pay one dispensing fee every three months instead of three dispensing fees if you were to fill up to a 30-day supply over three months.
4. You also have the option of substituting a **lower-cost alternative** drug if you and your doctor agree this is the right course of action for you.

Costco Pharmacy

For a prescription for antibiotics or any other prescription drug for short-term use that needs to be filled right away, the Costco Pharmacy is the place to go. If you are going to Costco anyway for one of your weekly grocery trips, you might as well fill a prescription at the same time and mark two items off of your “to do” list. You do not have to be a Costco member to fill a prescription and benefit from the low dispensing fees.

Express Scripts Canada Pharmacy[®]

If you are currently taking a maintenance drug to treat a chronic condition, such as asthma, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes and others, the Express Scripts Canada Pharmacy[®] can fill the majority of your prescriptions within 48 hours. Some of its many advantages include free delivery to your doorstep in Canada, refill and renewal reminders so you don't forget to fill your prescriptions and an auto refills service to take care of all of this for you. Plus, you have the comfort of knowing pharmacists are on call 24/7 if you have any questions or concerns.
